

ADAPTABILITY

On your toes! Have a plan in mind before handing out the cards. What activity(s) are you doing? What is your purpose or goal? Being adaptable is not the same as being unprepared.

Then, let it go! Part of the magic of the cards is their organic ability to open space for people to connect and communicate. Remember there are no wrong answers when it comes to ULEAD Cards.

Instead of having answers, have more questions. What does your group believe, feel, or think about what they are experiencing or hearing?



CONFIDENCE

You got this! Know the instructions for the activity and be ready to offer clear, concise directions to speed things up. If you notice any confusion, take the time to ask the group what they need help understanding.

Make sure you clarify or even demonstrate with a partner if that would help the team. Plus, the more confident and prepared you are, the more likely you will be able to work with their questions.

Then ... go BIG! Invite your group to have fun with the activities.



ENGAGEMENT

No “sideliners”! Go ahead and join in with your group; first with a smile and then with gleam in your eyes. By participating in card activities, you help your group see you as a co-learner in growing understanding and building relationships.

Part of the joy of the cards is being able to share a laugh or insight with each other and you should have a chance to experience that as well.

You are a part of the team; so unless your participation is going to hinder the results, join in the fun!



TIMING

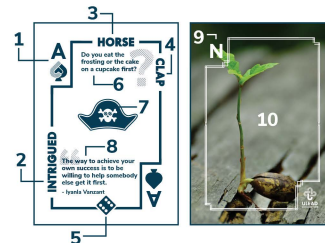
Keep it moving! Give time limits to your group. Even if they haven't completely finished the activity, encourage them to keep moving.

Don't cut people off or frustrate them with short time limits but definitely don't drag out the activities.

It is always better to leave participants wanting more rather than to leave participants dreaming about when it will end.
